











### Climate finance 2022 by federal ministry

#### Bilateral climate finance 2022 by region



Germany channels **most of its climate finance** through bilateral cooperation. In **2022, around 80% (€ 5.25 billion)** of the budget allocated to climate finance went towards bilateral cooperation; the remaining 20% (€ 1.14 billion) went towards the German government's multilateral activities.
